**Irlanda Mayo** is Deaf and was raised in hearing latin family. She was mainstreamed in public schools at FLA. Irlanda Graduated with a Deaf Ed masters degree from Western MD College. She is currently raising 3 young hearing children and has taught at NCSD for 18 years now.

**Daisy Wooten** graduated with BA degree in Communication Arts, Gallaudet University, Washington DC, and MA degree in Deafness Rehabilitation, New York University, New York.
